A Roman's Life: Children will explore what life was like in the Roman Empire, comparing Roman coins with modern day coins, sharing Roman stories and poems, dressing up as Romans and sharing performances of poems they have developed.

EXPERIENCE

Trip to Brandon Marsh Nature Reserve to investigate the science of rocks, flowers and bees, and food chains.
Potential Roman experiential visit.

CREATE

Children will design and create Roman Shields. They will develop the initial shape and structure, ensuring it is strong enough and fit for purpose. They will then learn and develop skills in painting of printing and finally create a finished shield utilising all of these techniques.



Visit to a local Nature Reserve to learn about Nature and Science in the local area.

Investigate how our community has been shaped due to the Roman's in Britain.

Understand how their life was formed due to the Roman's and consider numerous possibilities that may have happened without the Roman's.

We will consider how life would have been as a Roman Soldier and learn to use the values they must have shown.

Children will design and reinforce Roman Shields, considering how to make theirs the strongest and most suitable for war.
