To understand civilisations achievements and in-depth study of Ancient Egypt.




ART & DESIGN

- Plan sculptures through drawing and other preparatory work.
- Adapt work as and when necessary and explain why.
- Confidently create simple forms.



GEOGRAPHY

As Geographers, the children will identify the physical and human features of the country Egypt.

NATIONAL CURRICULUM

- Use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied.



LEARNING ACROSS THE CURRICULUM ENGLISH



In Year 5, the children will be reading the historical fiction text 'Secrets of a Sun King' by Emma Carroll. They will be showing their understanding of the characters by writing a news report and developing a balanced argument about whether Egyptian artefacts



SCIENCE

As Scientists, the children will observe the changes that take place during oxygenation. They will investigate what happened to the organs from a body during the mummification process.
